**Rehearsal and Commencement Ceremony Schedule**  
**Academic Year 2024**

The rehearsal and commencement ceremony for academic year 2024 will take place at the Kitiyakhan Grand Auditorium, Thammasat University, Rangsit. The graduates of the bachelor’s degree : on Saturday, January 17, 2026 – Sunday, January 18, 2026 and the graduates of master’s degree and PhD programs : on Sunday, January 18, 2026. ## 2. Rehearsal Schedule

**1<sup>st</sup> Rehearsal** This rehearsal will be announced and organized by each faculty commencement committee.

The proceeding of receiving the degree certificate; paying homage, receiving the degree and stepping back, will be explained in detail at the rehearsal.

**2<sup>nd</sup> Rehearsal** The university-wide rehearsal will be held for graduates of all faculties on Friday, January 9, 2026 at the Kittiyakhan Grand Auditorium, Thammasat University, Rangsit.

**3<sup>rd</sup> Rehearsal** The dress rehearsal : Group 1 will rehearse on Saturday, January 10, 2026, Group 2 and Group 3 will rehearse on Sunday, January 11, 2026 at the Kittiyakhan Grand Auditorium, Thammasat University, Rangsit.

**Session 1:** Graduates will rehearse the commencement ceremony procedures, from the beginning to the end of the ceremony, such as rising from the seat, proceeding to the stage to receive the degree certificate, paying homage, returning to the seat, making an oath, singing Thammasat University's anthem 'Yoong Thong', followed by the Royal Anthem. It is important that the graduates perform accurately in unison and within the scheduled time.

**Session 2:** The rehearsal will be conducted as it would be in the actual ceremony.

The rehearsal of group 3 of each faculty will be conducted according to the degree, starting from PhD, master’s degree, and diploma degree, respectively.

The honorary degree recipients will attend the dress rehearsal only.

All graduates who wish to participate in the Commencement Ceremony must register no later than Thursday, 20 November 2025, through the provided link or by scanning the QR code from the Office of the Registrar. Failure to complete registration within the specified period shall be deemed as a waiver of the right to participate in the Commencement Ceremony

5. Graduates are required to attend all three rehearsals. Those who cannot participate any rehearsal must request to be excused from the rehearsal by completing the in absentia request form, and submit evidence to the dean.

Following is the code of conduct in case where any graduates cannot participate in the rehearsals:

5.1 Absence from the 1<sup>st</sup> rehearsals

Permission to be absent must have prior approval from the dean. In case where they receive the permission, the faculty will set another rehearsal schedule in which the graduates must participate, the faculty will inform the list of the graduates who have been approved to be excused from the rehearsal to the Academic Affairs.

5.2 Absence from the 2<sup>nd</sup> rehearsals and dress rehearsal

Permission to be absent will be approved only for necessary reason. The graduates must apply using in absentia request form, the faculty will present it to the Vice-Rector of the Academic Affairs for approval.

6. Dress Code

6.1 1<sup>st</sup> rehearsals and 2<sup>nd</sup> rehearsals

- 1) Graduates of bachelor degree programs are asked to wear uniform.
- 2) Graduates of PhD and master's degree programs should wear black or non-vibrant tones to reflect the deep gratitude for Her Majesty Queen Sirikit The Queen Mother. T-shirts and sandals are not allowed. It is recommended that female graduates wear skirts.

6.2 Dress rehearsal

Graduates are required to wear the graduation gown as stated in the manual.

6.3 Those who graduated with the 5<sup>th</sup> year standing of the Reserve Officer Training Cops Student Curriculum and hold the rank of Acting Sub Lieutenant must present the letter of appointment to the university and faculty commencement committee on the day of dress rehearsal if they wish to wear the army uniform with insignia on the commencement day.
