16.15 ✦ The President of the University Council & Executives ✦ Form a line to welcome Their Majesties the King and Queen on the side of the Auditorium.

17.00 ✦ **Their Majesties the King and Queen arrive at the Auditorium.** ✦ Upon the commencement of the orchestral fanfare, all graduates should stand promptly.

✦ Their Majesties the King and Queen enter the reception room.

✦ **Their Majesties the King and Queen leave the reception room** to the royal seats in the auditorium. ✦ The officials of the Public Relations Department play **the royal hymn**¹ as soon as HM the King leaves the reception room.

✦ **HM the King lights the incense sticks** and pays homage to the Buddha image. ✦ The graduates perform a “wai” or place palms together at chest level while HM the King lights the candles and incense sticks.

✦ HM the King returns to the royal seat.

✦ The graduates sing and **pay their respects together**, then take seats (after HM the King has taken his seat).

- The representatives of the executive board respectfully present the commemorative booklet.
- The Rector respectfully **submits a report of Thammasat University** and receives the royal guidance.

✦ **Royal guidance by HM the King**

✦ The graduates stand and pay respects, then stand upright to receive the royal address **(noted from the lifting of the microphone).**

✦ The officials of the Public Relations Department play **the royal anthem**² at the end of the royal guidance.

✦ **The graduates do not sing; only the melody is played.** Once it ends, the graduates pay their respects simultaneously and then take seats.

- ◆ The President of the University Council respectfully submits the proclamation honoring the 6 distinguished honorary doctors.
- ◆ The President of the University Council respectfully requests the conferral of honorary doctoral degrees to be presented individually by HM the King.
- ◆ The Rector addresses the President of the University Council to represent the university in receiving the royal diploma for graduates, the Master's degree diploma, and the Doctoral degree diploma.
- ◆ The deans of each faculty respectfully request the admission of graduates to receive their degrees from HM the King in the following order: (Total: 4,044 persons) *.

- ☛ The honorary doctorates stand to pay their respects one by one as the President calls their names and reads their biographies, before walking to stand by the side of the stage.
- ☛ The graduates applaud after each honorary doctorate receives their diploma from the hands of HM the King.
- ☛ The graduates applaud as the President receives the degree from the royal hands.
- ☛ The graduates of the Faculty of Law in the front row rise from their seats, paying their respects in unison before standing at the stairs of the stage. (They rise after the President calls upon one doctoral graduate.)
- ☛ The first graduate of each faculty walks to stand at **the circle point when the Dean starts speaking**. He/she faces the royal seat and pays respects once on behalf of the faculty graduates immediately.

at the Kittiyakhan Grand Auditorium, Thammasat University, Rangsit Center

- 09:00** ♦ **The auditorium is open.**
- ♦ Doctoral/Master's/Diploma graduates from all faculties take their seats in the Kittiyakhan Grand Auditorium in order of their assigned faculties and seating arrangements.
- 09:30** ♦ **The doors of the Kittiyakhan Grand Auditorium are closed and the names of graduates are checked**
- 10:00** ♦ The President of the University Council presides over the ceremony. He stands and walks to pay respect to the Statute of Buddha on the altar, then walks to pay respect to the royal portrait, opens the flower tray in front of the royal portrait, pays respect, and goes back to the seat
- ♦ **Graduates sing the royal anthem**
- ♦ **The Rector makes an announcement to the President of the University graduates from Council to begin the ceremony**

- ☛ A graduate representative says, **“Graduates, stand up.”**
- ☛ Graduates **stand up straight**
- ☛ Public Relations Department Officer plays **the royal anthem¹**. (when the President of the University Council returns to his seat.)
- ☛ **The graduates sing a hymn¹** in praise of HM the King, accompanied by the melody from the lyrics “Aao-ma-no-lae-si-ra-kran.”
- ☛ The graduates finish singing, pay respect, and sit down.
- ♦ The first row of PhD and Master's degree the Faculty of Law begin to rise from their seats, pay respect together, and then stand on the stage (at point X opposite the Dean) to prepare to receive their diplomas.

♦ Deans of faculties/ colleges/ offices read the names of graduates who will receive their degrees from a tray in front of the royal portrait in the following order (totaling approximately 1,617 people)*

 - ☛ The graduates stand up, pay respects and stand straight, **holding their degrees against their chest.**
 - ☛ The graduate representative **leads the oath-taking**
 - ☛ The graduates **recite after him and then pay respect** (at the end, **do not recite** “duay-khao-duay-kra-mom-Kor- Day-cha.”)

- ◆ **The graduates sing the royal anthem**
 - ☛ Public Relations Department officials play **the melody of the royal anthem**²
 - ☛ **The graduates sing the royal anthem with a melody**, starting with the lyrics “Aoa-ma-no-lae- si-ra-kran”
 - ☛ The graduates finish singing, pay their respects together, and stand straight.
- ◆ The executives offer Thai offerings to the monks.
- ◆ The graduates sing “Yoong Tong”
 - ☛ Public Relations Department officials play the melody of **the Song “Yoong Tong.”**
