



Thammasat University Notification
on
Measures for the Monitoring of Cannabis and Hemp Use on Thammasat University Premises

Whereas it is deemed expedient to set out the preventive and monitoring measures on the use of cannabis and hemp on Thammasat University premises, under authority of Section 39 (1) of Thammasat University Act of B.E. 2558, Thammasat University hereby issues a declaration on the measures and principles on the use of cannabis and hemp as detailed below:

1. Thammasat University premises are cannabis-free zones except for study, research and medical purposes.
2. On campus, the sale of cannabis, hemp and their parts are forbidden. Any foods, snacks, drinks or any products having cannabis and hemp as an ingredient are also forbidden.
3. The promotion of foods, snacks, drinks or any products containing cannabis and hemp are banned on university property.
4. University units are responsible for educating and providing the correct understanding as well as raising awareness of the use of cannabis and hemp among Thammasat University students and staff.
5. All four Center Administration Divisions (Tha Prachan, Rangsit, Lampang, Pattaya) shall cooperate with food vendors and suppliers on and around the university to monitor the ban on sales of cannabis, hemp and their parts as well as any foods, snacks, drinks and products containing cannabis and hemp.
6. All relevant university staff must perform a monitoring function to ensure strict compliance with this announcement.

Effective from today onwards.
