Guidelines for Classes, Teaching and Learning Arrangements for Academic Year 2022

In view of the improving situation of Covid-19 in Thailand, along with the measures, orders and announcements made by the Ministry of Higher Education, Science, Research and Innovation and other governmental agencies prevailing in every location of all university campuses to relax the COVID-19 prevention measures, permitting the use of the university's buildings and premises for the purpose of holding classes, examinations, training sessions and any other activities with a large number of participants to proceed under the official prevention measures:

Thammasat University hereby announces the guidelines on classes, teaching and learning arrangements that from Semester 1, Academic Year 2022, the onsite mode of instruction will be fully performed at all campuses to ensure Thammasat students the maximum learning potential while strictly adhering to the measures for the prevention of COVID-19 according to the Ministry of Public Health.

However, in case of future disease outbreaks or major emergency such as riots or any types of disasters, the faculties, with approval of their committee and notification of the university for acknowledgement, can be flexible in delivering the appropriate modes for learning, teaching and examination of individual subjects, whether hybrid or online, depending on the circumstances and subject requirements. Accordingly, the adjustment of these study formats must not cause unnecessary burden on students and all involved.
