



Thammasat University Notification
on
Measures and Recommendations on the Prevention and Control of Coronavirus 19
(COVID-19)(No. 10)

With regard to Thammasat University Notification No. 9 on Measures and Recommendations on the Prevention and Control of Coronavirus 19 (COVID-19), which extended the suspension of office activities to 30 April 2020, now the Prime Minister has issued a notification on 28 April 2020 mandating the extension of the state of emergency in the whole kingdom from 1 May to 31 May 2020. Additionally, another notification was made on 29 April 2020 in accordance to Article 9 of the Emergency Decree on Public Administration in Emergency Situations, B.E. 2548 (No. 4), stipulating that notifications or orders by the Bangkok Governor, provincial governors, officers controlling contagious diseases (according to laws on contagious diseases), and authorized persons according to aviation and immigration laws, which were given or issued earlier, would continue effective until further notifications are made. With concern for the health of staff and students having to commute to work or attend educational activities, Thammasat University hereby issues the following measures in order to help prevent the recurrence of wide-spread infection in the spirit of social responsibility.

1. Offices must be temporarily closed at Thammasat University Ta Prachan and Rangsit from 1 May 2020 until further notice. Officers will continue to work from home according to guidelines prescribed by Thammasat University Notification No. 6 on Measures and Recommendations on the Prevention and Control of Coronavirus 19 (COVID-19). In case personnel are required to work at their office in situations whereby their absence would cause damage, such as experiments or research in laboratories, the Faculty/Institute head or responsible Vice Rector shall exercise his/her discretion and grant permission on a case-by-case basis, under strict compliance with public health and hygiene measures.
2. Classes will continue to be conducted in accordance to Thammasat University Notification No. 7-8 on Measures and Recommendations on the Prevention and Control of Coronavirus 19 (COVID-19) until further notice.
3. Undergraduate and graduate entrance exams will be further suspended until 31 May 2020 except when exams are administered online.
