



Thammasat University Notification
on
Measures and Recommendations on the Prevention and Control of Coronavirus
(COVID-19) (NO. 22)

Pursuant to Thammasat University Notification on Measures and Recommendations on the Prevention and Control of Coronavirus (COVID-19) No. 21, upon monitoring the current situation of the spread, and following the announcement of the Center for COVID-19 Situation Administration (CCSA), it is evident that the number of infected cases has continued to rise in almost every province of Thailand. With concern for the health, and for the purpose of prevention and risk reduction of infection among university personnel and students having to travel, to work, or to participate in a variety of activities,

To respond to these incidents, Thammasat University hereby issues the following measures:

1. From 16 to 30 April, 2021, faculty members and university staff shall work from home. Furthermore, the Vice Rectors/Assistant Rectors/Deans/Directors/Faculty or Institute Secretariats/or the equivalent position shall take turns working at their offices while maintaining efficiency, preventing any impacts on work and strictly complying with public health measures.

The Office Heads/Vice Rectors in charge shall delegate staff to work at the office, if necessary, to prevent any impact on work.

Those offices that have the mission of servicing students shall consider providing online channels or online services and notifying the students of those channels/services.

2. Classes, teaching, examinations, meetings, seminars and activities will be conducted online. If the online format is not feasible, the responsible heads shall exercise their discretion as deemed appropriate while strictly complying with public health and hygiene measures. Such actions must be reported to the university for acknowledgement.

Effective from 14 April 2021 onwards until further notice.
