Information and Guidelines for Students and Staff

On Coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) Infection Case of a Staff of the National Science and Technology Development Agency (NSTDA)

On 21 December 2020, the National Science and Technology Development Agency (NSTDA) issued a statement on Coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) infection of a staff .

As NSTDA is situated near Thammasat University Rangsit Campus, to prevent the spread of COVID- 19, Thammasat University provides the following information and instructions.

1. NSTDA staff infected with COVID- 19 did not use the canteen or visit public areas at Thammasat University Rangsit Campus.
2. Students or staff who have been to NSTDA premises, or who reside at the same dormitory as the infected person, or who have had close contact with the infected person from 1 December 2020 onwards are requested to register and complete the COVID- 19 Surveillance Form via the TU COVID- 19 Line and observe their own symptoms for 14 days.
3. Thammasat University has preventive and preparedness measures in place, as prescribed in Thammasat University Notification of Measures to Control Coronavirus (COVID- 19) (No. 14). Staff and students at all campuses are requested to strictly comply with the measures until further notice.
4. Students or staff who display symptoms suggestive of COVID- 19infection may make inquiries or notify the Health Promotion Center, Students Affairs Office, SC Building Floor 1, Thammasat University Rangsit Campus, Tel. 02-696-6600 to 2. Those who have concerns about the spread of COVID- 19, may seek consultation from the Viva City Center, Tel. 02-028-2222 press 2.
