



**Thammasat University Notification**  
**on**  
**Measures and Recommendations on the Prevention and Control of Coronavirus**  
**(COVID-19) No. 20**

Pursuant to Thammasat University Notification on Measures and Recommendations on the Prevention and Control of Coronavirus (COVID-19) No. 19, and the monitoring of the situation in Thammasat University, it reveals that a staff from the Faculty of Law and a student from the Faculty of Medicine have been tested positive to COVID-19. Both of them have been admitted to hospitals for medical treatment immediately on 13 and 14 February 2021 respectively. Thammasat University is coordinating with the hospitals to ensure that our staff and student receive the best medical treatment in accordance with standards, while the university is ready to provide any further treatment support. Moreover, the University has provided COVID test for the people who had close contact with the two persons at Thammasat University Hospital. As of now, 55 of them have been tested negative, while 5 other cases are awaiting the results.

To prevent the spread of COVID-19, Thammasat University hereby issues the following measures.

1. Faculties, staff, and students who have been in the same place/area as the infected staff and student during 14-day period prior to the 13 February 2021, are required to observe a 14-day self-quarantine starting from 13 February 2021 onwards. The absent days will not be counted as leave days.

2. Faculties, staff, and students who have shown some suspected symptoms of COVID-19 from direct contact to the infected staff and student, are required to contact Thammasat Well-Being Center at the Student Affairs Office, 1st Floor, Social Science Building, Rangsit Center, Tel. No. 02-696-6600-2, for further instructions.

3. Vice Rectors/Deans/Directors shall strictly follow and comply with the measures issued by the Ministry of Public Health, The Center for Covid-19 Situation Administration (CCSA), Ministry of Higher Education, Science, Research and Innovation (MHESI), and Thammasat University.
