



**Thammasat University Notification**

**Financial Assistance Measures for Students during the New Wave of COVID-19**

---

Pursuant to the new wave of COVID-19 infections having caused a wide-range impact on Thai society and the world, Thammasat students have also been affected financially. Thammasat University hereby issues the following measures to assist students having registered in Semester 2/2020, both in Thai and international programs.

**1. Financial Assistance for Tuition Fees during the New Wave of COVID-19**

- 1.1 Financial assistance for tuition fees of 1,500 Baht will be provided to each undergraduate student having registered in Semester 2/2020. Eligible students shall contact their faculty/college/institute to provide details of their bank account for the fund transfer.
- 1.2 In case a Faculty/College/Institute gives additional financial assistance for tuition fees in the above-mentioned semester for students in their international programs, it will be notified by the Faculty/College/Institute respectively later.

**2. Scholarships for the Students, Affected by the New Wave of COVID-19**

- 2.1 Scholarships will be provided to undergraduate students having registered in Semester 2/2020, both in Thai and international programs, who are affected by the new wave of COVID-19. There are two rates of the scholarships as follows:
  - 5,000 Baht for 1,000 undergraduate students
  - 2,500 Baht for 1,000 undergraduate students
- 2.2 Scholarship of 5,000 Bath will be provided to 500 postgraduate students each having registered in Semester 2/2020, both in Thai and international programs, who are affected by the new wave of COVID-19

Eligible students wishing to apply for above-mentioned scholarships shall apply online through the **Thammasat Scholarships** webpage (administered by Student Affairs Division) from now until 28 February 2021.

- 2.3 In case the Faculty/College/Institute provide additional scholarships for their students, it shall be notified by each Faculty/College/Institute later.
