



Thammasat University Notification
on
Measures and Recommendations on the Prevention and Control of Coronavirus
(COVID-19) No. 16

Pursuant to Thammasat University Notification on Measures and Recommendations on the Prevention and Control of Coronavirus (COVID-19) (No. 15), the university has been monitoring the spread situation by which the infection numbers are increasing in many provinces of Thailand. Accordingly, the Center for COVID-19 Situation Administration's (CCSA) has designated 4 types of control areas, while Pathum Thani Province issued the Order No. 12430/2564 on Closure of Venues with Infection Risks and Measures to Control and Prevent the Spread of COVID-19 Infectious Disease dated 1 January 2021, of which Article 1.12 stipulates the closure of all educational institutions, in line with Bangkok Metropolitan Administration Notification on Order to Temporarily Close Venues (No. 15) Article 1.25, which requires the closure of venues at all educational institutions and prohibiting the use of venues for classes, examinations, trainings or other activities, that involve a large number of participants. With concern for the health of personnel and in order to prevent the spread of disease and reduce infection risks for faculty, staff and students having to travel for work or various activities,

Thammasat University hereby issues the following measures.

1. Thammasat University Ta Prachan, Rangsit, and Pattaya campuses shall be temporarily closed. There shall be no work at office or office contact during January 2-17, 2021. Staff shall return to work at the university on January 18, 2021 and offices shall set up and publicize contact channels to other offices and persons wishing to make contact during the closure.

2. Offices shall implement work from home, in accordance with Thammasat University Notification on Measures and Recommendations on the Prevention and Control of Coronavirus (COVID-19) No. 6.

Office heads or persons assigned by office heads shall delegate staff to work at office in necessary cases to prevent any negative effect to the office, under compliance with public health and hygiene measures.


Staff responsible for supporting video conferences or online communication, security, public health, staff payroll, procurement related processes or other financial matters shall work at office as assigned.

3. Staff and students shall avoid unnecessary travel to maximum control areas (red), control areas (orange) and high-risk areas (yellow). They shall follow updates and strictly comply with measures issued by the government and the university.

4. Personnel at Lampang Campus shall work according to Human Resource Office, Lampang Administration Division memo no. Or Wor 67.06.3/wor 1330 on Working at Office and Working from Home for Staff under Lampang Administration Division According to Measures to Prevent and Control Coronavirus 19 (COVID-19), dated 30 December 2020.

To take effect immediately.
