



Thammasat University Notification
on
Measures and Recommendations on the Prevention and Control of Coronavirus
(COVID-19) No. 17

Pursuant to Thammasat University Notification on Measures and Recommendations on the Prevention and Control of Coronavirus (COVID-19) No. 16, the university has been monitoring the spread situation by which the infection numbers are increasing in many provinces of Thailand. Accordingly, the Bangkok Metropolitan Administration issued the Notification on Order to Temporarily Close Venues (No. 16) dated January 4, in which Article 1 stipulates venue closures, while on January 8 Pathum Thani Province issued the Order No. 301/2564 on Closure of Venues with Infection Risks, to expand the closure of all educational institutions until January 31, 2021.

With concern for the health of personnel and in order to prevent the spread of disease and reduce infection risks for personnel and students having to travel for work or various activities, in accordance with Thammasat University Notification on Measures and Recommendations on the Prevention and Control of Coronavirus (COVID-19) No. 16 Article 1, Thammasat University hereby expands the closures of Ta Prachan, Rangsit, and Pattaya campuses until January 31, 2021. Personnel shall return to work at the university on February 1, 2021, unless there is further notice.
