



Thammasat University Notification  
on  
Measures and Recommendations on the Prevention and Control of Coronavirus  
(COVID-19) (NO. 29)

---

With reference to Thammasat University Notification on Measures and Recommendations on the Prevention and Control of Coronavirus (COVID-19) No. 28, and the Prime Minister's announcement on 17 July 20, under authority of Section 9 of the Emergency Decree on Public Administration in Emergency Situations B.E. 2548 (No.28), further designating COVID-19 Zoning Areas and declaring Chon Buri Province to be one of the maximum and Strict COVID-19 Control Zones with more stringent regulations and measures due to the increasing spread of the Coronavirus (COVID-19) that has mutated into several variants with increased severity, possibly leading to a crisis in the public health service system,

And with concern for the health and well-being of all individuals in the Thammasat community, to reduce congested areas and prevent the risk of infection by Thammasat University students and staff, who may have to travel to the university premises to perform their jobs and attend a variety of educational activities, Thammasat University hereby issues the following measures:

1. To extend the temporary closure of Thammasat University, Tha Prachan and Rangsit Campuses until 1 August 2021. This campus closure also applies to Thammasat University, Pattaya Campus. The operations of university units shall comply with Thammasat University Notification on Measures and Recommendations on the Prevention and Control of Coronavirus (COVID-19) No 28, Item 1.

For operations at Thammasat University, Pattaya Campus, whose functions are related to security, public health, system maintenance or others that require staff to work on site, they will be subject to a report made to the Vice Rector for Administration (Pattaya Center) as stipulated in Item 1 (paragraph 2).

2. The operations of Thammasat University at Lampang Campus shall continue in compliance with Thammasat University Notification on Measures and Recommendations on the Prevention and Control of Coronavirus (COVID-19) No 28, Item 2, unless otherwise notified.
3. All academic and support staff and students shall strictly follow and comply with the measures issued by the Thai government as well as local authorities.

These measures are effective immediately.
