



Thammasat University Notification  
on  
Suspension of Classes for University Cleaning

Pursuant to the spread of coronavirus 19 (COVID-19) presently being an issue of great concern, for the hygiene of students, staff and faculty members, and to prevent the infectious virus spread, Thammasat University considers fitting to suspend classes at Thammasat University, Ta Prachan Campus on the 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> of March, 2020 in order to implement a cleaning of the university campus. In so doing, Thammasat University will collaborate with the Phra Nakhorn District office to spray disinfectant at walkways and building exterior areas on the above days. For maximum effectiveness, university faculties and offices are requested to do the following.

1. Wipe clean equipment and areas inside buildings with disinfectant.
2. Install sufficient alcohol hand disinfectant dispensers for students and staff.
3. Lecturer are requested to assess the situation, i.e. if there are students recently returning from or transiting through areas or territories in the risk group (according to the Ministry of Public Health Notification <https://ddc.moph.go.th/viralpneumonia/index.php>) within the last two weeks or if there are students who may spread the virus, and cancel classes, using remote or online teaching as substitutes.
4. Assigned staff are requested to be present at work in order to take part in the cleaning of areas within their offices and the university.
