



Thammasat University Notification  
on  
Measures and Recommendations on Entry into Thammasat University Ta Prachan Campus  
for Rehearsal of and Participation in the 2018 Academic Year Commencement Ceremony

According to the rehearsal and actual date of the 2018 academic year commencement ceremony being scheduled for 3-4 and 9-10 April 2020, at Thammasat University Ta Prachan Campus Auditorium, and pursuant to the continuous spread of coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) in many countries, including the extensive spread of the virus in some countries, whereon the World Health Organization declared the epidemic a Public Health Emergency of International Concern (PHEIC) on 30 January 2020, and on 26 February 2020, the Minister of Public Health, as recommended by the National Communicable Disease Committee, declared coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) a dangerous communicable disease according to the Communicable Disease Act, B.E. 2558, in order to implement vigilance and control of the disease, Thammasat University hereby issues the following Measures and Recommendations on Entry into Thammasat University Ta Prachan Campus for Rehearsal of and Participation in the 2018 Academic Year Commencement Ceremony.

1. Persons permitted to enter Thammasat University Ta Prachan Campus for rehearsal of and participation in the 2018 academic year commencement ceremony are:
  - 1.1 graduates receiving their diplomas for academic year 2018
  - 1.2 faculty members, staff, students and outside persons assigned by Thammasat University to work in the rehearsal and actual commencement ceremony.
  
2. Persons in 1. are prohibited from entering Thammasat University Ta Prachan Campus for rehearsal and actual commencement ceremony if they:
  - 2.1 have traveled to or transited through countries or areas with continuous coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) spread and areas where it is advisable to avoid congested venues according to the Ministry of Public Health Department of Disease Control Notification, and have returned to Thailand from 14 March 2020 onwards
  - 2.2 have fever and a body temperature of more than or equal to 37.5 degrees Celsius along with one other symptom (cough, running nose, sore throat, shortness of breath).
  
3. Person in 1. attending the rehearsal and actual 2018 academic year

commencement ceremony are requested to observe the following measures:

- 3.1 pass through screening at the Tha Phra Arthit or Ta Prachan university gate and comply with disease control measures specified by the university whereupon persons of risk may be refused entry into the area on a case by case basis
- 3.2 prepare plain white or light colored face masks for use while on campus
- 3.3 refrain from bringing on campus congratulatory flowers, gifts and souvenirs.
