Measures and Recommendations on the Prevention and Control of Coronavirus 19
(COVID-19) (No. 3)

Pursuant to the continuous spread of Coronavirus 19 (COVID-19) in many countries, particularly China, Hong Kong, Taiwan, Japan, South Korea and Singapore,

Thammasat University is concerned about the well-being of its faculty members, staff, and students. The University has implemented continued monitoring and follow-up measures and requests Deans and heads of university agencies to inform faculty, staff and students to comply with the Ministry of Public Health Department of Disease Control's recommendation on the Prevention and Control of Coronavirus 19 (COVID-19)

In the instance where faculty, staff or students are scheduled to travel to risk group countries, they are requested to postpone their travels, if possible, until the situation has improved. If travel is necessary, faculty, staff and students are requested to take precautions and protect themselves by preparing sufficient face masks and sanitizing alcohol gel. When they return, they should strictly comply with the screening process at the health check points.

Thammasat University, the Faculty of Medicine, and Thammasat University Hospital will closely monitor the situation. Should the spread of Coronavirus 19 (COVID-19) be upgraded to a higher level or should there be any changes in notifications from the Ministry of Public Health or related agencies, Thammasat University will expeditiously notify its community of appropriate measures to undertake.
