Measures and Recommendations on the Prevention and Control of Coronavirus 19 (COVID-19) (No. 5)

Pursuant to the continuous spread of coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) in many countries, and the extensive spread of the virus in some countries, additionally on 30 January 2020, the World Health Organization declared the epidemic a Public Health Emergency of International Concern (PHEIC), and on 26 February 2020, the Minister of Public Health, as recommended by the National Communicable Disease Committee, declared coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) a dangerous communicable disease according to the Communicable Disease Act, B.E. 2558, in order to implement vigilance and control of the disease, Thammasat University hereby issues the following measures to be observed by faculty members, staff and students in addition to Thammasat University Notification on Measures and Recommendations on the Prevention and Control of Coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) (No.4).

- 1. Approvals and permission for faculty members, staff and students to take leave and travel to or transit through areas with continuous spread of coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) and areas where it is advisable to avoid congested venues according to the Ministry of Public Health Department of Disease Control Notification, which were granted before the date of this notification and from the date of this notification to 31 May 2020, are revoked. Thereby, expenses approved and incurred before the date of this notification may be disbursed according to the urgent letter from the Ministry of Finance no. gor kor 0408.4/vor.35 lor vor. 2 March 2020, subj. Approval of Disbursement Principle in Cases of Cancellation of Postponement of Official Travel, Trainings, Events and International Conferences Impacted by the Spread of Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19).
- 2. Faculty members, staff and students traveling to or transiting through other countries not listed in the group of countries or areas with continuous spread of coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) and areas where it is advisable to avoid congested venues according to the Ministry of Public Health Department of Disease Control Notification are requested to report themselves by completing the coronavirus 2019 monitoring report form accessible through the QR code provided in the Notification on Measures and Recommendations on the Prevention and Control of Coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) (No. 4) without having to defer coming to work or to class.

In case of a fever of 37.5 degrees Celsius along with one other symptom (cough, running nose, sore throat, shortness of breath), the person is requested to see a doctor at
