



Thammasat University Notification
on
Measures and Suggestions on the Prevention and Control of Coronavirus 19 (Covid-19)
(No. 6)

Pursuant to the continuous spread of coronavirus 2019 (Covid-19) in many countries, and the extensive spread of the virus almost all over the world, on 11 March 2020, the World Health Organization (WHO) declared the outbreak a “pandemic” in the global scale. There is also a report that a certain number of Thammasat students have visited some risky places for Covid-19. Although they are under quarantine in accordance with the epidemic control procedures, for preventive purposes and risk reduction for personnel and students, Thammasat University hereby issues the following measures, which shall also help prepare online teaching and university operation if the spread is increasing.

1. All classes at Tha Prachan and Rangsit will be cancelled during March 16 (Mon.) – 22 (Sun.), 2020. Classes can resume on March 23 (Mon.), 2020 unless there is further announcement.
2. All Faculties/Colleges/Institute must prepare arrangements and supporting systems for online teaching and make them operable by March 23, 2020.
3. All administrative and supporting units, Office of the University’s Council, and Internal Audit Office will convene a meeting on March 16 (Mon.), 2020 to deliberate on how to “work from home” for staff and then propose to the Vice Rector in charge of each unit, which shall include the followings:
 - 3.1 To determine the types of work and officers who will take turn to work in their office as per necessary from March 17, 2020 onwards.
 - 3.2 To assign officers to work from home on some days or weeks (depending on the type and requirements of work). Here, there should be clear objectives, indicators, procedures for communication, follow-up, and work report.

For other units, please do as deemed necessary and appropriate.

4. All faculty members, staff, and students shall be attentive to the training on online teaching and learning, which the university will announce shortly.
