



Thammasat University Notification  
on  
Measures and Recommendations on the Prevention and Control of Coronavirus  
(COVID-19) (NO. 35)

---

With reference to Thammasat University Notification on Measures and Recommendations on the Prevention and Control of Coronavirus (COVID-19) No. 34, and the Prime Minister's announcement on 30 October 2021, under authority of Section 9 of the Emergency Decree on Public Administration in Emergency Situations B.E. 2548 (No.37) and the announcement on 12 November 2021, under authority of Section 9 of the Emergency Decree on Public Administration in Emergency Situations B.E. 2548 (No.38), gradually easing the Covid-19 safety measures in accordance with the improvement in the severity of the situation:

In order to prevent the spread of the Coronavirus (COVID-19) among Thammasat students and staff, as well as to maintain the efficient operations of the university, Thammasat University hereby issues the following measures:

1. The university will permit entry only to those who have received permission or have been assigned to work.

University units whose functions are related to security, public health, system maintenance, student coordination, the use of university premises for classes or others that require their staff to work on site will be subject to the discretion of that unit head and responsible Vice Rector. The total number of persons permitted to enter the campus must not exceed 50 percent of the total number of staff or students affiliated with that university unit.

Outsiders who need to enter the premises of Thammasat University should contact the relevant section in advance.

2. Persons who will be permitted to enter onto the campuses of Thammasat University are required to have been double-vaccinated by vaccines approved and sanctioned by the Food and Drug Administration not less than 14 days prior, unless there are exceptional circumstances. Such persons must strictly follow the COVID-19 prevention measures determined by the university's section, the university and the government.

3. Teaching, assessment of student learning and student activities will continue to be delivered online unless it is deemed necessary to be organized by using another format, and those related to academic affairs or student development programs shall be implemented according to the guidelines issued by the Office of Student Affairs.


4. The operations of schools situated on the premises of Thammasat University, Rangsit campus shall comply with the announcements of the related government agencies. The Vice Rector supervising Rangsit Campus may determine any further measures deemed appropriate.

5. The Vice Rector for Administration (Lampang Campus) and Legal Affairs may determine the operations of Thammasat University at Lampang Campus by implementing staff work patterns via work rotation arrangements or any further measures deemed appropriate.

6. All academic and support staff and students shall strictly follow and comply with the measures issued by the Thai government as well as local authorities.

This announcement shall be effective from 1 December 2021 – 31 December 2021 unless otherwise announced.
