



Thammasat University Notification
on
Measures and Recommendations on the Prevention and Control of Coronavirus
(COVID-19) (NO. 33)

With reference to Thammasat University Notification on Measures and Recommendations on the Prevention and Control of Coronavirus (COVID-19) No.32, and the Prime Minister's announcement on 28 September 2021, under authority of Section 9 of the Emergency Decree on Public Administration in Emergency Situations B.E. 2548 (No.34), promulgating additional regulations and measures for government units due to the spread of the Coronavirus (COVID-19), followed by an announcement of the Ministry of Higher Education, Science, Research and Innovation regarding its criteria and guidelines in reopening institutions of higher education in the first phase from November, 2021 onwards:

In order to prevent the spread of the Coronavirus (COVID-19) among Thammasat students and staff as well as to maintain the efficient operations of the university, Thammasat University hereby issues the following measures:

1. Offices at Tha Prachan, Rangsit and Pattaya Campuses will continue to be temporarily closed until 31 October 2021. University operations are to be suspended. University units shall implement a work-from-home arrangement for their staff. Individual offices must determine communication channels and publicize them for efficient operations.


University units whose functions are related to security, public health, system maintenance or others that require their staff to work on site to ensure ongoing operations will be subject to the discretion of that unit head and responsible Vice Rector while strictly complying with the requirements, announcements and orders of the government, the Center for COVID-19 Situation Administration (CCSA) and local government agencies, including announcements of the Ministry of Higher Education, Science, Research and Innovation on Measures and Surveillance of Coronavirus disease (Covid-19) as well as the operation guidelines for institutions of higher education prescribed by the Ministry of Higher Education, Science, Research and Innovation. Such unit heads or Vice Rectors must report the grant of permission for on-site working to either the Vice Rector for Administration (Tha Prachan) and International Affairs, the Vice Rector for Rangsit Campus Administration (Campus Life), or the Vice Rector for Administration (Pattaya Center), depending on their base campus.

2. The operations of Thammasat University at Lampang Campus shall continue to implement a work-from-home policy. The Vice Rector for Administration (Lampang Campus) and Legal Affairs may determine staff work patterns, work rotation arrangements or any further measures deemed appropriate.

3. All academic and support staff and students shall strictly follow and comply with the measures issued by the Thai government as well as local authorities.

These measures will be effective from 1 October 2021 onwards.
